Team Awesome took their walk at Reinstein Woods, making their way out to Beech Tree Trail. They were given a spectacular display, as the great blue heron spread its massive wings and flew by very close.

Team Lightning Bird headed over to Como Lake Park. Their favorite birds they observed were mallards, woodpeckers, and a cooper's hawk.

Team Bird Quest walked through the Reinstein Woods sanctuary, heading out on Lily Pond Loop. They were amazed by the sheer size of the pileated woodpecker. They also enjoyed stopping to check out the beaver lodge.
