### **Seasonal Volunteer Positions**

(Must be 18 years or older, or need a parent/guardian to volunteer.)

<u>Community Service Hours</u>: We offer trail, habitat maintenance and community science projects for anyone seeking service hours. Trainings are held throughout the year. Make sure to fill in hours needed on the volunteer form!

<u>Habitat, Trail & Garden Stewards:</u> Assist us from May to October of each year. Volunteers help with trail clean-up, invasive species removal, maintain compost bins, weed herb or flower gardens and help with small outdoor projects.

<u>Phragmites Strike Team:</u> Assist staff from May to September of each year. Volunteers learn about and how to remove the invasive species Phragmites (common reed) from the preserve.

<u>Community Science Steward:</u> We currently have seven community science projects (CSP) available. We offer a training session for each project, so make sure to look for our program schedule for training announcements on line or at the education center. You must attend training to participate in following CSPs:

- BudBurst: (March—November) Record phenophases.
- Bee Navitars: (March-August) Record bees and flowerheads.
- FrogWatch USA: (March–August, after sunset) Record sounds of frogs and toad near ponds and wetlands.
- FeederWatch: (November—March) Record species of birds visiting our feeders at the Education Center.
- **Hummingbirds at Home: (April-August)** Record number visiting feeder or flowers.
- Monarch Watch: (July-August) Record adult monarch butterflies.
- Wildlife Tracks & Scat: (December—February) Record species of wildlife that make tracks and scat in the snow on the trails.

## <u>Year-Round Volunteer Positions</u> Age requirement: 18 years or older

<u>Assist DEC Staff</u> at the education center during the day on weekdays and weekends to help with programs, winter ski and snowshoe rentals, and event set-up and clean-up.

<u>Greeters</u> are needed to answer phones and visitor questions in the Education Center. Duties may include copying and folding or helping with basic office needs. Training will be provided.
